Report of 1st EBSU International Students Induction Programme

Internationalization is an important aspect of University education globally and Ebonyi State University has keyed into the scheme. The international programmes that currently attract foreign students to the University include;

- 1. European Union funded Intra-Africa Academic Mobility programme, known as MoBreed
- 2. European Union funded Intra-Africa Academic Mobility programme, called GENES
- 3. World Health (WHO) funded 1st and the only African Institute of Health Policy and Health System.
- 4. Student and staff exchange MoU with the Phytobiotechnology Research Foundation (PRF) in Cameroun, affiliated with the Catholic University of Cameroun.

Ebonyi State University organized her first ever welcome/orientation programme for the students on Friday 31st May 2019. The programme was declared open by the Vice Chancellor of Ebonyi State University, Elder Prof. Chigozie N. Ogbu, and featured the following presentations;

- 1. "University Internationalization: Ebonyi State University Status" by the Coordinator of the University's International Office for Partnerships and Cooperation and the Head of Biotechnology Department, Dr. Celestine A. Afiukwa.

Oselebe, represented at the programme by the Head of Applied Biology Department, Dr. Catherine V. Nnamani.
- 3. "Highlights on the postgraduate academic regulations of Ebonyi State University" by the Dean of the School of Postgraduate Studies, Prof. Eugene N. Nweke.
- 4. "Documentation and travels information for foreign students in Nigeria" which was presented by the Head of Nigerian Immigration Services in Ebonyi State.
- 5. "Banking & financial services for International students in Nigeria" delivered by the representative of the Branch Manager of Zenith Bank PLC, Ogoja Road Branch, Abakaliki.
- 6. "Health insurance for foreign students in Nigeria" presented by the representative of the Manager of IGI Insurance Company, Ebonyi State Branch.

- 7. General information about "Life, food, markets, cost of living, culture & religion of the people of Ebonyi State" scholarly delivered by Dr. Nkechi Emma-Echiegu.
- 8. "Health services supports & contacts" by the University's Director of health services, Dr. Enoch P. Onwe.

The presentations highlighted the importance of university internationalization, the progress Ebonyi State University has made and still making towards internationalization, and ways to make the foreign students stay in the University safe and pleasurable.
